Answer Key

Today is the 7th Sunday of Easter or the Ascension of the Lord. It is the Ascension in most dioceses except Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Omaha and Philadelphia according to my liturgical calendar

The feast of the Ascension celebrates when Jesus ascended, body and soul, into heaven. He gives His blessing to the disciples.

The Sanctuary lamp is usually red, next to the tabernacle and reminds us that Jesus is present there. At the end of services on Holy Thursday, it is extinguished when all the consecrated hosts are taken from the tabernacle. It is then re-lit after Communion at the Easter Vigil Mass.
