There are 10 Commandments:

- 1. I am the lord thy god: thou shalt not have strange gods before me.
- 2. Thou shall not take the name of the lord thy god in vain.
- 3. Keep the sabbath holy.
- 4. Honor thy father and thy mother.
- 5. Thou shalt not kill.
- 6. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 7. Thou shalt not steal.
- 8. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
- 9. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife.
- 10. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's goods.
