## Answer Key

Today is the First Sunday of Lent; Lent is 40 days and at the end, we celebrate Easter, which is Jesus' Resurrection. The Church asks us to pray, fast and give alms as a way to prepare for Easter and also to recall the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness.
