Today is Pentecost Sunday, the birthday of our Church!

Readings: Acts, Psalm 104, 1 Corinthians, John

Red is the color for the Holy Spirit, it is also worn for martyrs' feast days, on Good Friday and Palm Sunday.

The Holy Spirit came upon Mary and the apostles like tongues of fire and rested on them. It doesn't say over their heads, but artists often portray it that way.

The Extended Mass is for the Vigil of Pentecost, there are 4 Readings, 4 Psalms, an epistle (letter) and the Gospel.
